Storm Drain Marking Event Scheduled for October 14th

(TEMPLE, TX – October 11, 2017) The City of Temple Stormwater Program will be hosting the annual Storm Drain Marking event with Girl Scout Troop 8226 on Saturday, October 14th, at 10:00 a.m. in the Stonegate Subdivision in Temple.

“The Storm Drain Marking Program is a hands-on project for volunteers who are interested in educating the citizens of Temple about pollution prevention,” states Temple’s Stormwater Program Specialist Kara Godineaux. Girl Scout Troop 8226 will volunteer their time by affixing steel buttons to 18 storm drain inlets within the Stonegate Subdivision.

“Storm drain markers are a reminder that storm drains lead to our creeks, lakes and streams.” says Godineaux. “Debris, chemicals, trash, dirt and other pollutants that come in contact with stormwater also enter the storm inlets. These inlets lead to the same waterways that we use for swimming, fishing and ultimately it is where our drinking water originates before treatment.”
