Central Counties Services moved their headquarters into the King's Daughters Hospital building in 1975 where they currently operate. The 50,000 sq. ft. King's Daughters Hospital building is over 100 years old with the first fireproof wing built in 1913. In 1957 the hospital received a grant to remodel the old nursing dormitory into 12 patient rooms. However, the location became inadequate for the growing hospital. In 1983, the land and hospital were deeded to Central Counties Services by the Board of Directors of King's Daughters. For over 50 years, Central Counties Services has been a recognized service expert in Central Texas for person with Mental Illness, Intellectual Disabilities and Developmental Delays.
