



## ATHLETIC LEAGUES Reopening Guidelines

**WELCOME BACK!** We look forward to serving you again. Here is some updated information on how we are ready to re-open for visitors!

- **League Registration Opens Monday, June 8, 2020. League specific deadlines apply.**
- As always, the safety of our staff and our patrons is our number one priority.
- Registrations accepted Monday through Thursday 8:30 am – 4:30 pm via phone at (254) 298-5690 or in person by appointment only at the Parks and Recreation Offices located at 1701 N. General Bruce Dr.
- There are no gym rentals at the Clarence Martin Gym until further notice.
- Individual field rentals requests will be accepted beginning June 15. Rentals will begin the week of June 22 based upon availability.
- Tournament rental requests will be accepted beginning June 22. Tournament rentals will begin July 11, 2020 based upon availability.
- *Please note, public health guidance cannot anticipate every unique situation. Individuals should stay informed and take actions based on common sense and wise judgment that will protect health and support economic revitalization.*

### ADULT LEAGUES

- Men's Softball
  - Registration deadline June 17, Season June 29 – August 7
  - Enforce additional distance between home plate umpire and catcher/batter
- Co-Ed Soccer
  - Registration deadline June 17, Season June 30 – August 13
  - No penny jerseys will be provided by PARD
- Men's Basketball
  - Registration deadline June 24, Season July 6 – August 26
  - No penny jerseys will be provided by PARD
- Co-Ed Volleyball
  - Registration deadline June 24, Season July 7 – August 27
- Co-Ed Softball
  - Registration deadline July 1, Season July 12 – August 30
  - Enforce additional distance between home plate umpire and catcher/batter
- Co-Ed Kickball – not offered until further notice

### HOW OUR RECREATION TEAM IS WORKING TO KEEP A SAFE ENVIRONMENT

- ALL LEAGUES:
  - No handshakes, huddles, high-fives, etc. allowed.
  - Team managers only will complete scorecards.

- STAFFING: Athletic Leagues will be staffed with Recreation Staff at each facility or field during league play.
- FACILITY SANITIZATION:
  - Restroom facilities will be cleaned and sanitized prior to first games each day.
  - Restroom doors, where applicable, will be left open to minimize touching of door handles.
  - Dugouts will be sanitized during daily cleaning of facilities prior to use.
  - Bleachers will be sanitized during daily cleaning of facilities prior to use.
  - Scorer's table will be sanitized during daily cleaning of facilities prior to use.
  - Water fountains are not available. Please bring your personal water bottle. Water will be available for purchase at concession stands (where applicable) during games.
  - Additional time may be added between games to allow any necessary equipment and facility sanitization.
- PPE: Consistent with the actions taken by many individuals across the state, all spectators should consider wearing cloth face coverings (over the nose and mouth). If available, spectators should consider wearing non-medical grade face masks.
- SOCIAL DISTANCING:
  - At outdoor events spectators are encouraged to bring their own chairs.
  - Individuals should avoid gathering in groups larger than ten (10) people.
  - Minimize in person contact.
  - Maintain six (6) feet of separation from individuals outside your household.
- CONCESSIONS:
  - Plastic countertop shield will be installed.
  - Countertop area to be sanitized multiple times throughout duration of games.
  - Staff are required to wear masks and gloves.
  - Require additional handwashing cleanliness upon entering and exiting and in between customers.
  - Require individual condiment packages and utensil packaging.
  - Encourage social distance spacing for customers in line.
  - Contactless payment is encouraged but not required.
